

# Municipal Occupational License

Occupation tax, power to levy, exceptions. A city of the first or second class and villages may raise revenue by levying and collecting a license tax on any occupation or business within the limits of the city or village, and regulate the same by ordinance. All such taxes shall be uniform in respect to the classes upon which they are imposed: Provided, all scientific and literary lectures and entertainment shall be exempt from such taxation, as well as concerts and other musical entertainments given exclusively by citizens of the city or village. See 16-205; 17-525 Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943.
